

Container Packing Certificate

Person(s) responsible for packing the vehicle or container should complete this checklist. Sign the certification.

It is hereby declared that the undersigned has visually inspected container number _____ and certifies that:

- The container was clean, dry and apparently fit to receive the goods.
- Packages which need to be segregated in accordance with applicable segregation requirements have not been packed together onto or in the container (unless approved by the competent authority concerned in accordance with 7.2.2.3)
- All packages have been externally inspected for damage, and only sound packages have been loaded
- Drums have been stowed in an upright position, unless otherwise authorized by the competent authority, and all goods have been properly loaded and, where necessary, adequately braced with securing material to suit the mode(s) of transport for the intended journey
- Goods loaded in bulk have been evenly distributed within the container
- All packages have been properly packed in the container and secured.
- For consignments including goods of class 1 other than division 1.4, the container is structurally serviceable in accordance with 7.4.6
- The container and the packages therein are properly marked, labeled, and placarded.
- When solid carbon dioxide (CO₂ – Dry Ice) is used for cooling purposes, the container is externally marked or labeled in a conspicuous place, such as, at the door end, with the words: "DANGEROUS CO₂ - (DRY ICE) INSIDE, VENTILATE THOROUGHLY BEFORE ENTERING."
- A dangerous goods transport document, as indicated in 5.4.2.1, has been received for each dangerous goods consignment loaded in the container
